

Worst Case Scenario Demonstration/Informative Speech

Assignment: look in the Worst Case Scenario books on reserve in the library and/or research methods for handling the particular challenge you have received. Prepare a 5-7 minute presentation.

Dress: You should dress the part for a person who would likely be giving the presentation.

Audience: Be sure to establish who we are as an audience and why we would need to know this information. (Note: you can use a one minute video clip to set the scene if you want.) We will not pay attention if we don't see an immediate application to us.

Props/Demonstration: You are expected to include props that would be appropriate for your topic (equipment/supplies, etc.). You should have a demonstration of how to perform the desired action. (You can have a classmate do the action while you talk.)

Video Clips: You can use video clips to establish the need to illustrate something about the action.

PowerPoint: You should have one to three slides, no more, to list steps and/or provide summary.

This is to be a very **VISUAL** presentation. You may use notes, but you are expected to be actively involved in presenting your topic. Don't read your notes to us.
