INTRODUCTION: Does the introduction cover social/historical/cultural context or writer's bio/style/works? Does the introduction BRIEFLY (2-3 sentences) summarize the literary analysis? Suggestions for improvement?

Is the **thesis statement** clearly stated (last sentence in Introduction)? Is there a Literary Element? Is there a Theme? Is the theme universalized, not particularized?

DEVELOPMENT: Does the **body of the paper** support the thesis? Are there examples of the LITERARY ELEMENT in the paper and explanations of how it shows the theme? Suggestions for improvement?

DEVELOPMENT: Is the paper **developed** enough? *Enough* specific and convincing examples and details?

COHERENCE: Does the paper "flow"? Are the ideas stated in logical order? Are the transitions between sentences and ideas effective and clear? Is the paper itself clear and understandable or confusing? Suggestions for improvement?

STYLE: What do you think of the style and tone of the paper? Is the sentence structure too simple or too convoluted? Is it difficult to follow? Is the word choice specific and interesting or dull and general?

MECHANICS: Mechanical problems? Grammar, punctuation, spelling?

DOCUMENTATION: If research is required, are there BOTH parenthetical in-text citations and a bibliography page? Do they use correct MLA or APA documentation?

What is your overall impression of the essay? What did the author do especially well? What do you like about it? Suggestions for improvement?
